The inaugural Police Mental Health Symposium will provide a forum for policing agencies to discuss the challenges and global best practice in mental health policy. Experts and policing leaders will convene in Washington DC on 2 June 2017 to discuss:

- Building resilience and knowledge
- Long-term officer engagement and staff support programs
- Addressing stigma around mental health issues.

The symposium is specifically targeted at a policing audience, and will be informed by the experiences of serving police officers. The symposium is a full-day event and will include a working session to equip participants to develop outcomes specific to their agency.
